Aspiring lawyers have their day in court



Thirty Sharples students (from years 9 and 10) visited Manchester Crown Courts last week to take part in a workshop recreating a criminal trial and to learn more about careers in the law.

First, we met Cath from the National Justice Museum who introduced the court system as a working environment.

Then we met Curtis, an apprentice solicitor at Manchester firm Eversheds. Curtis gave us a young person's perspective on the legal profession and explained the apprenticeship as an alternative route to qualification.

Finally, we worked with Cath to recreate a criminal trial with Sharples students role-playing the judge, court officials, prosecution teams, defence teams, the jury and witnesses. We all found this great fun as well as gaining a valuable insight into working in the court system.

Being able to do this in a real court room brought it all to life. As we walked back through the courts, on our way home, our students saw everything in a new light. Plenty for us all to think about as students start to plan their future career paths.

Year 9 Visit to Three Sisters Race Circuit



As part of the ProtoEV Kart challenge, six Year 9 pupils visited the Three Sisters Race Circuit (in Wigan) to test different go-karts. The pupils had the chance to complete laps in both an electric and petrol go-kart to identify the strengths and weaknesses of each. This will be useful when they convert their own petrol go-kart into an electric one.

Pupils were quick to discover how well the electric kart accelerated compared to the petrol go-kart and were keen to put their engineering skills to the test once the Sharples School go-kart is delivered. The go-kart will then be used on the track day in July when the pupils will be racing against other schools and colleges from around the North West.

Festival of Chemistry

On Wednesday, four Year 8 pupils travelled to the University of Manchester to take part in Salters' Festival of Chemistry. They competed against other schools from the North West in two activities. The activities required the pupils to work together, utilising their problem-solving and practical skills. Firstly, they had to identify a criminal using chromatography. In addition to this, they had to create a 'chemical stopclock' which would last exactly one minute. The activities were followed by an excellent 'Science Show' which was enjoyed by all who attended. Thanks to both Salters and the University of Manchester for hosting the event.
