What is the Student Affairs Committee?

The Student Affairs Committee at Sharples has been established since 2017. The main aim of the SAC is to act on behalf of their peers within the school that may not have the confidence to use that voice. Students meet with Mr Charlton at least once each half term where there are lots of points discussed that students may wish to voice their opinions. Staff may also ask for an additional meeting to ask for feedback on specific matters. An example being events or rewards. Student Affairs Committee members are visible by their Purple Ties, please stop them to raise any points or concerns you may have.

Interviews for the 17 shortlisted students have been arranged for the WC 31st October. Students have been informed of their interview time and date.

The Y7 application process has commenced this term with forms being sent and interviews have been arranged. It has been fantastic to see so many Y7 students engage with the SAC Application process.

Student Affairs Committee members will be assisting with the Y7 interview process with each member being invited to take part. **We have had over 50 applications for the SAC which is a testament to the fantastic enthusiasm Y7 have shown since their arrival in September!**

So far this term, The SAC have met with Mr Charlton to discuss matters with school life such as our rewards system, our adoption of silent starters in lessons, stock levels and food availability in our canteen & Y10 pod and the standards gates around school.

SAC members have also met with Ms Webster to feedback their opinions on matters and it was fantastic to see the voice and opinion being valued and respected.

It has been fantastic to see already some of the SAC's work being implemented this year such as the alteration of the reading in assemblies. Students are now shown the book of the week on display rather than having their individual reading book as some pupils felt they did not have enough time to engage with their reading book.



Sharples Open Morning's

The Student Affairs Committee were delighted to assist with School's Open Mornings with around 15 students being involved. Students were situated in our fantastic new library where potential students and parents could ask questions regarding life at Sharples as well as our Committee. It was brilliant to see SAC members take pride in their school and conduct themselves in such a positive and professional manner. Feedback has been extremely positive and students enjoyed the chance to be able to represent Sharples, we hope you enjoyed these mornings just as much as we did!

Meeting with Ms Webster

We were thankful to Ms Webster for meeting with us this half term to voice our concerns and pass on feedback from peers. There were lots of positive outcomes from the meeting including the lowering of our rewards boundaries as follows;

- 150 Points for Bronze
- 300 Points for Silver
- 450 Points for Gold

Students also raised concerns with the poor weather and entrances to school, with the solution being students will be allowed to enter school earlier if the weather is particularly poor one day. SAC members were also encouraged to give details to peers regarding the upcoming 'Diversity Day' which will run on the last day of term.

Other points that members raised included the PE changing rooms, food availability in the Y10 Pod, lack of Netball courts and the entrances into School.

Twitter

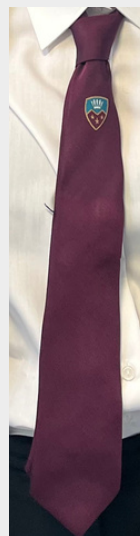
